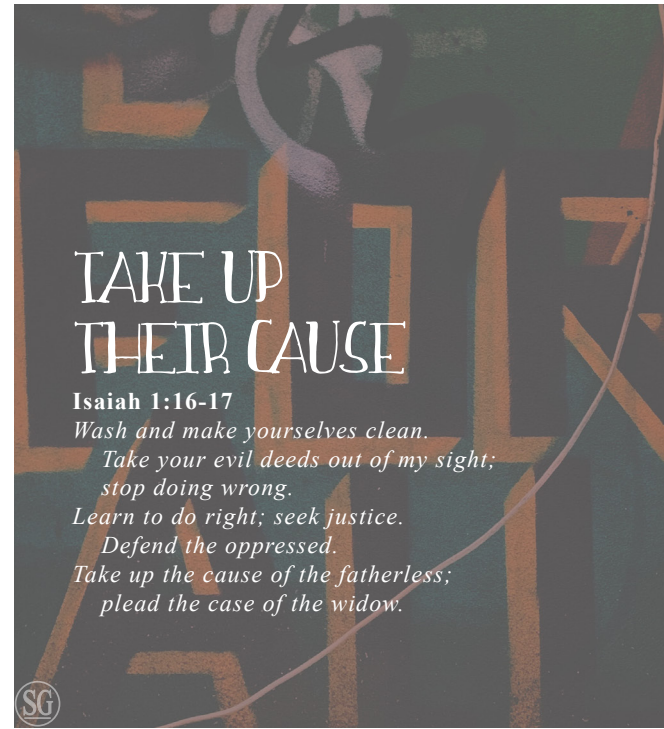
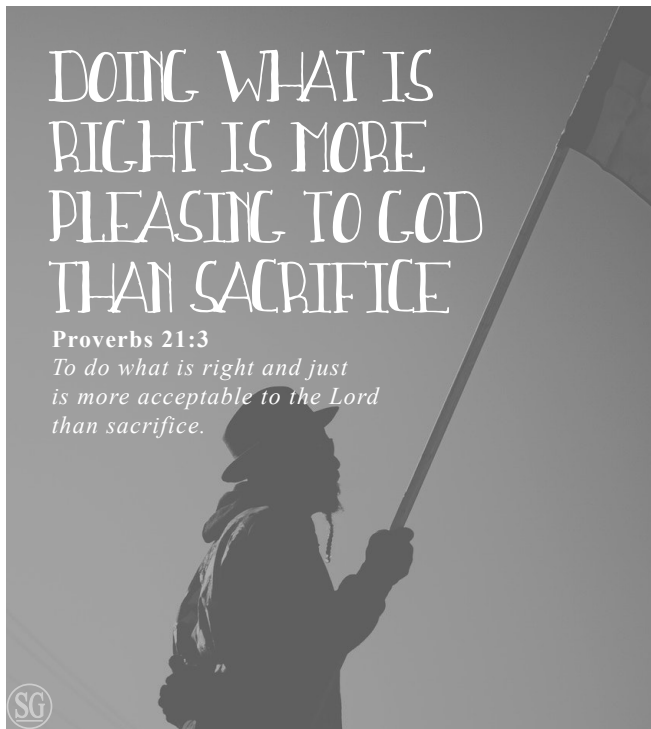
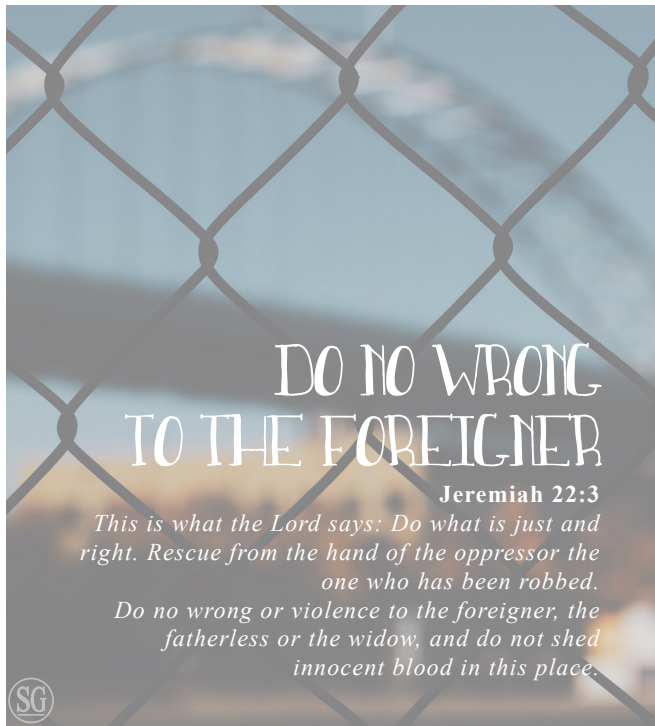


JUSTICE CARDS

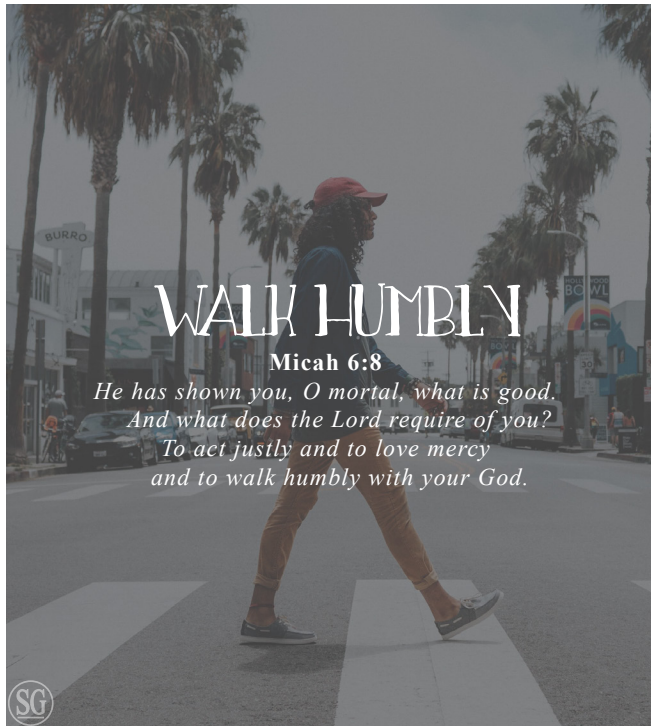


DO NO WRONG TO THE FOREIGNER

Do no wrong or violence to the foreigner, the fatherless or the widow, and do not shed innocent blood in this place.

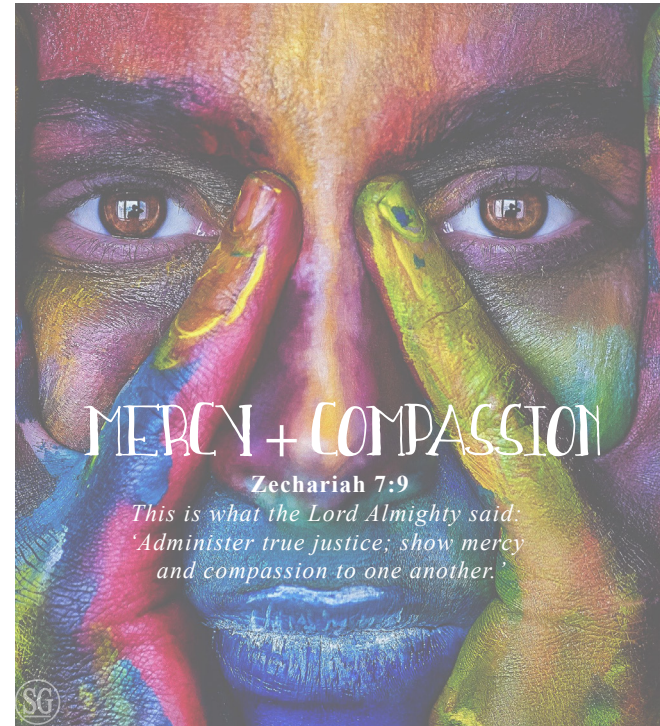


WALK HUMBLN

And what does the Lord require of you?*

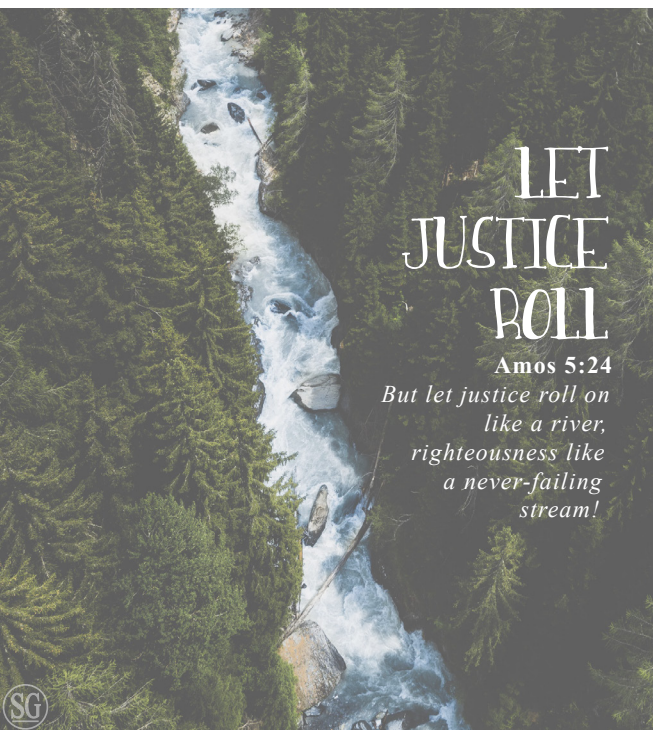
*To act justly and to love mercy

Zechariah 7:9

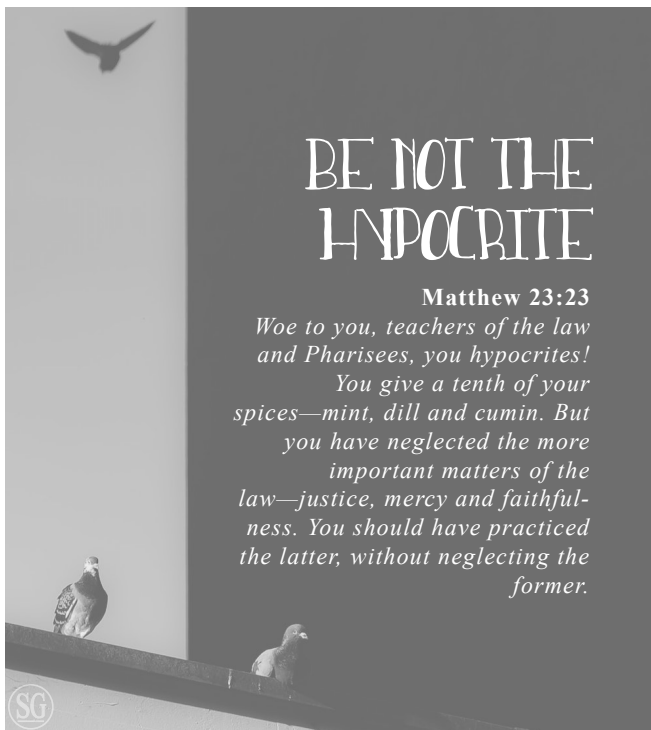
*This is what the Lord Almighty said:
